He was only one finger tall!

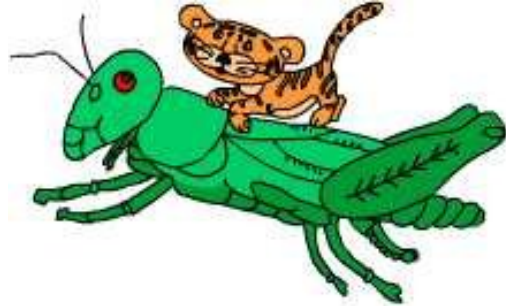
The Itty Bitty Tiger

Like a jumping jack!

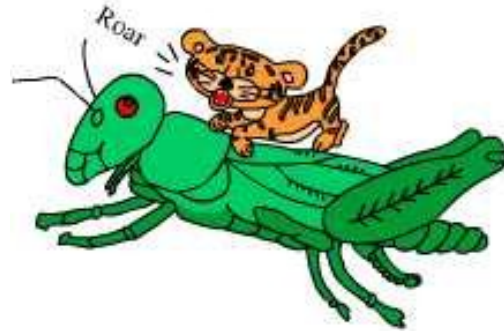
Hold on tight!
